With the help of many supporters, Prosperity Ready has achieved the following outcomes.

MISSION ADVANCEMENT

- Served **65** immigrant job seekers, an increase of over **440%** verses 2021.
- Connected **23** immigrant job seekers into living wage jobs with outstanding benefits, an increase of over **660%** verses 2021.
- Doubled the number of organizations who support our work from **16 to 32**.
- Expanded our group of talented volunteers from **22 to 30**.
